AIPAC and our 2.7 million members work to strengthen and expand the U.S.-Israel relationship on a bipartisan basis.

The AIPAC PAC was founded in December 2021 to support pro-Israel candidates and members of Congress, and in just one year we delivered more money directly to candidates than any other PAC in America.

We endorsed **365 candidates** over the course of the election cycle, and **98**% of AIPAC PACendorsed candidates won their general election races.

AIPAC endorsed 365 members and candidates for Congress.

We were proud to support 100% of the Democratic and Republican leadership teams.

PRO-ISRAEL LEADERS



Congresswoman Shontel Brown (D-OH)

Congresswoman Shontel Brown is a progressive African American woman and a pro-Israel leader. She was challenged in the Democratic primary by an anti-Israel candidate backed by Bernie Sanders, AOC, and Rashida Tlaib. With strong support from AIPAC members, Rep. Brown defeated her opponent by 33 points.



Congresswoman Haley Stevens (D-MI)

AIPAC members raised more than \$1 million for pro-Israel Congresswoman Haley Stevens in her primary race against a Bernie Sanders and J Street-backed opponent. Rep. Stevens defeated Andy Levin by 20 points.



Congressman Glenn Ivey (D-MD)

Glenn Ivey defeated an anti-Israel former member of Congress who was backed by Elizabeth Warren, Pramila Jayapal, and J Street. AIPAC members contributed more than \$750,000 to his campaign and he defeated his opponent by 16 points.



Congressman Ken Calvert (R-CA)

Congressman Ken Calvert is a pro-Israel leader in line to be the chair of the Defense Appropriations Subcommittee. Redrawn district lines made this a competitive district. AIPAC members raised \$100,000 for his campaign and helped him defeat his opponent.



Congressman Don Bacon (R-NE)

Congressman Don Bacon is an outspoken pro-Israel champion who was challenged in his reelection campaign by a candidate endorsed by J Street. AIPAC members across the country raised significant resources for Bacon's campaign in the final weeks, and helped propel him to a 3-point victory.



Congresswoman Young Kim (R-CA)

First-term pro-Israel Congresswoman Young Kim faced an anti-Israel Republican challenger in the primary. With significant financial support from AIPAC members and our grassroots GOTV efforts, Rep. Kim defeated her opponent and was reelected to Congress in November.



AIPAC PAC IS THE LARGEST PRO-ISRAEL PAC


In just one year, AIPAC PAC emerged as the largest pro-Israel PAC in America, and dollar-for-dollar is the largest contributor to candidates in American politics.

The AIPAC PAC distributed more than \$3 million to 365 candidates this election cycle. The PAC is supported exclusively by AIPAC members from across the country, who can each contribute a maximum of \$5,000 each year.

In addition, more than **6,000 AIPAC members** contributed an additional **\$14.5 million** to pro-Israel members of Congress and candidates through the AIPAC PAC.
